#### **BEGINNINGS OF PHARR SOUTH 1979 - WRITTEN BY ELAINE COX (former owner and historian)**

"Pharr South Adult Community is the most recently developed park of its kind in the Rio Grande Valley.

The developers, Charles Cummings and Robert Perry, purchased the 60-acre grove late in the summer of 1979. The City of Pharr approved Subdivision #1 that same year. The first plat included 19.24 acres for 117 lots and 2.8 acres for the commons area. The subdivision provided that the ownership and maintenance of all streets and drainage improvements remain with the Homeowners Ass'n. All lots were to be sold and title given to each purchaser. Many phase one lots were sold in 1979. By spring of 1980, the first 1/3 of the recreational hall was erected and the swimming pool completed.

Phase two, consisting of 22.6 acres and 160 lots, was begun in the summer of 1980 and sold by the winter of 1981. During 1980, the ballroom was extended to its present size.

The laundry and billiard room building was under construction during late 1981 and was available for use in 1982.

Phase three was started in the summer of 1981 and all but a few of the lots remained to be sold by March 1, 1982. At that time, management and ownership of the common area was turned over to the property owners.

The common area also contains a greenhouse, ten shuffleboard courts, two horseshoe pits, a golf putting green and a croquet court.

Pharr South is the most successful adult community of its kind. Most of the success can be attributed to the first buyers who promoted the park, developed a community spirit and encouraged others with the same spirit and pride to join them in ownership. The pride in ownership, concern for the welfare of others, unselfish contribution for the betterment of the park and friendliness sets it apart from other parks of its kind.
